


MAP Overview

The MAP program was created to help our students maintain “*Test Readiness.*” This is achieved by pairing students who request help with a Peer Mentor.

Our Mentors are selected by ensuring they maintain a GPA of 3.5 or higher, and are trained to recognize what areas of study a student may require help in.

Students are encouraged to take advantage of our Mentoring services. They are absolutely free of charge. Mentors will only divulge any information discussed during your sessions with an instructor or the Student Services Advisor with your permission and/or if there are significant concerns.

What is the MAP Program?

The MAP Program is designed to help students develop studying skills. Students who meet certain requirements are trained to “Mentor” those who are looking for help.

Some requirements to Mentor are a GPA of 3.5 or higher, showing qualities suggestive of leadership, and having an interest in helping others. They must be at least one full term or semester ahead of the person in need of assistance.

This program has shown to help improve test scores and GPA's, giving our students the confidence they need in order to be “Test Ready.”

How do I join the Program?

Though there are no requirements to be met in order to request assistance from a Mentor, we do ask that a Mentee puts forth full effort. Students may ask any instructor or Mentor for a request form for Mentoring. The form will be given to the Student Services Advisor, who will assign a Mentor for the student. The Mentor and Mentee will then decide when it is best for them to meet so they may begin their studying sessions.

Can I become a Mentor?

To ensure our students are getting the best help, there are requirements to become a Mentor:

- Maintain a 3.5 GPA
- Work well with others
- Help students achieve “Test Readiness”
- Agree to policies set forth in the MAP Guidebook

This program is available to students in any HTC program. Request forms are kept by instructors, as well as in Student Services. You may also ask an active Mentor.

What are the benefits to this program?

The obvious benefit is the improvement seen by our students who have utilized the program in the past. There are other benefits, as well. Students are able to realize their potential, and confidence is strengthened. Social skills are gained, and leadership skills are sharpened.

Those who Mentor are required to complete training. Mentorship can be a great resume builder, so Mentors are encouraged to participate in any workshops or meetings that may be held.
